**HIGHWAY 64 UTILITY ADJUSTMENTS
WYNNE, ARKANSAS**

Separate sealed bids for the construction of the Highway 64 Utility Adjustments will be received by the **Wynne Water and Sewer Commission** of the City of Wynne, Arkansas until 1:30 pm, on August 31, 2010 at the Wynne Water Treatment Plant, 706 W. Martin, Wynne, Arkansas and then at said time and place publicly opened and read aloud.

The project consists generally of water and sewer line adjustments and relocations associated with Job No. 110504 of the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department. The principle element of work consists of the installation of approximately 4,710 feet of 2-inch through 10-inch PVC water line, 500 feet of 6-inch PVC sewage force main and 791 feet of 8-inch PVC gravity sewer, together with incidental and ancillary work.

The Contract Documents, consisting of Advertisement for Bids, Information for Bidders, Bid Form, Bid Bond, Agreement, Performance and Payment Bond, General Conditions, Wage Rates, Drawings, Specifications, and Addenda may be examined at the following locations:
