**Item No. 1. Advertisement - Change Bid Opening Date and Time**

- a. Sealed Bids for **Raw Water Transmission Pipeline, Contract 3: Lake Hamilton to Timberlake Drive** will be received by Olivia Thomason at the **City of Hot Springs Finance Department**, 324 Malvern Avenue, Hot Springs, Arkansas 71901 no later than **10:00 AM CDST on June 28, 2021**. After 10:00 AM on June 28, 2021 bids will be received at Hot Springs City Hall in the Board Chambers, 133 Convention Boulevard, Hot Springs, Arkansas 71901 until **11:00 AM CDST, June 28, 2021**, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

**Item No. 2. Sheet 3 – General Notes (not re-issued)**

- a. Add Note 17.A.b. as follows:
  - b. Ductile Iron Pipe***
- b. Revise Note 17.B as follows:

***All steel pipe shall meet the requirements of the steel pipe specifications, as included in Specification 331102 - Steel Pipe of the project specifications. All ductile iron pipe shall meet the requirements in Specification 331100 of the project specifications.***
- c. Revise Note 17.D as follows:

***All trenching, backfill, and bedding to meet requirements shown in the details and specifications for this project. The same bedding and backfill requirements apply to both Steel Pipe and Ductile Iron Pipe.***

**Item No. 3. Specification 331100 – Water Pipe and Fittings (not re-issued)**

- a. Add Section 1.3.E. Submittals as follows:

***E. Contractor shall provide a summary and supporting calculations for required restrained pipe lengths for the entire project.***
- b. Add Section 1.3.F. Submittals as follows:

**F. Contractor shall provide a lay schedule with supporting calculations, as well as a summary of the location and type of fittings as required for the entire project.**

- c. Revise Section 2.2.G.4. as follows:

**Restrained push-on joint pipe shall meet the requirements in section 2.4.**

Item No. 4. **Specification 331102 – Steel Pipe (not re-issued)**

- a. Revise Sub-Section 1.3.J. to show the following:

**J. Pre-Qualified Steel Pipe Manufacturers shall include:**

- 1. American Spiral Weld Pipe Company**
- 2. Northwest Pipe Company**
- 3. Mid America Pipe Fabricating & Supply, LLC**
- 4. Thompson Pipe Group**

Item No. 5. **Form C-410 Bid Form (see attached)**

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**ARTICLE 1 – BID RECIPIENT**

1.01 This Bid is submitted to:

1.02 The undersigned Bidder proposes and agrees, if this Bid is accepted, to enter into an Agreement with Owner in the form included in the Bidding Documents to perform all Work as specified or indicated in the Bidding Documents for the prices and within the times indicated in this Bid and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.

**ARTICLE 2 – BIDDER’S ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS**

2.01 Bidder accepts all the terms and conditions of the Instructions to Bidders, including without limitation those dealing with the disposition of Bid security. This Bid will remain subject to acceptance for 30 days after the Bid opening, or for such longer period of time that Bidder may agree to in writing upon request of Owner.

**ARTICLE 3 – BIDDER’S REPRESENTATIONS**

3.01 In submitting this Bid, Bidder represents that:

A. Bidder has examined and carefully studied the Bidding Documents, and any data and reference items identified in the Bidding Documents, and hereby acknowledges receipt of the following Addenda:

B. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, alert visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and Site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

C. Bidder is familiar with and has satisfied itself as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

D. Bidder has carefully studied all: (1) reports of explorations and tests of subsurface conditions at or adjacent to the Site and all drawings of physical conditions relating to existing surface or subsurface structures at the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings, and (2) reports and drawings relating to Hazardous Environmental Conditions, if any, at or

adjacent to the Site that have been identified in the Supplementary Conditions, especially with respect to Technical Data in such reports and drawings.

- E. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and any Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.
- F. Bidder agrees, based on the information and observations referred to in the preceding paragraph, that no further examinations, investigations, explorations, tests, studies, or data are necessary for the determination of this Bid for performance of the Work at the price bid and within the times required, and in accordance with the other terms and conditions of the Bidding Documents.
- G. Bidder is aware of the general nature of work to be performed by Owner and others at the Site that relates to the Work as indicated in the Bidding Documents.
- H. Bidder has given Engineer written notice of all conflicts, errors, ambiguities, or discrepancies that Bidder has discovered in the Bidding Documents, and confirms that the written resolution thereof by Engineer is acceptable to Bidder.
- I. The Bidding Documents are generally sufficient to indicate and convey understanding of all terms and conditions for the performance and furnishing of the Work.
- J. The submission of this Bid constitutes an incontrovertible representation by Bidder that Bidder has complied with every requirement of this Article, and that without exception the Bid and all prices in the Bid are premised upon performing and furnishing the Work required by the Bidding Documents.

#### **ARTICLE 4 – BIDDER'S CERTIFICATION**

4.01 Bidder certifies that:

- A. This Bid is genuine and not made in the interest of or on behalf of any undisclosed individual or entity and is not submitted in conformity with any collusive agreement or rules of any group, association, organization, or corporation;
- B. Bidder has not directly or indirectly induced or solicited any other Bidder to submit a false or sham Bid;
- C. Bidder has not solicited or induced any individual or entity to refrain from bidding; and

- D. Bidder has not engaged in corrupt, fraudulent, collusive, or coercive practices in competing for the Contract. For the purposes of this Paragraph 4.01.D:
1. “corrupt practice” means the offering, giving, receiving, or soliciting of anything of value likely to influence the action of a public official in the bidding process;
  2. “fraudulent practice” means an intentional misrepresentation of facts made (a) to influence the bidding process to the detriment of Owner, (b) to establish bid prices at artificial non-competitive levels, or (c) to deprive Owner of the benefits of free and open competition;
  3. “collusive practice” means a scheme or arrangement between two or more Bidders, with or without the knowledge of Owner, a purpose of which is to establish bid prices at artificial, non-competitive levels; and  
“coercive practice” means harming or threatening to harm, directly or indirectly, persons or their property to influence their participation in the bidding process or affect the execution of the Contract.

If an amount is entered here, the total base bid will be adjusted by subtracting line "B" from line "A", and the total amount in this line will be divided by the total length of pipe in items 1 thru 4 and then the unit price bid on those items will be adjusted by that per foot amount for payment on those items. For example: If the amount entered into this item is \$100,000 and the total length of pipe is 29,420 linear feet, the unit prices entered into pay items 1 thru 4 will be adjusted down by \$3.40 per linear foot.*
